- One pack of Baby wipes (unscented)

- Two complete changes of seasonally appropriate clothes: two shirts, two pairs of pants, two pairs of underwear, and two pairs of socks. Please label all items with your child's name and place in a Ziploc bag

- □ One box of gallon-sized Ziploc bags
- □ Two rolls of paper towels
- □ One pack of baby wipes
- □ 1 pack of crayons (do not label)
